Prayer:

Matthew 28:18-20 Empowered and Commanded to Mission

- v. 18 'all authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me'
consider: Prv. 8:15, Is. 9:6
Q – What changed for Jesus?
- v. 19 '(having gone), therefore disciple all the nations, baptizing them'
consider: Ps. 22:27-28, the Trinity: God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.
Q – Who is to go? What is discipling? How do we baptize into 3 names?
- v. 20 'teach them to obey (observe) ... I am with you'
consider: Deut. 5:32, Matt. 7:24-27
Q – How do we teach people to obey/observe? What part do we "make" them vs. letting people make their own decision?

Key themes of these verses to consider:

1. The Mission of God,
2. Disciple, Baptize and Teach, &
3. God is with us.

Prayer:

Lord, be with us this day, Within us to purify us; Above us to draw us up; Beneath us to sustain us; Before us to lead us; Behind us to restrain us; Around us to protect us.
